Mana Kura Tahī National Kapa Haka Competitions

Two buses are going

On Saturday 2 November 2019 the **kapa haka rōpū bus** will be leaving Masterton on a 50-seater Transit bus. This rōpū will not return until Saturday 9 November 2019. This rōpū will meet at Kura 8am and depart at 8.30am. They expect to arrive at Wāhi Marae at 5pm. The Pōwhiri for this rōpū will be at 5.30pm.

On Tuesday 5 November 2019 the **kapa tautoko rōpū** bus will leave Kura at 9.30am and travel to Mangakino on a 30-50-seater bus. Numbers going will determine the number of seats on this bus. The reason for this is because on our last trip to Mana Kuratahi we hired a 50-seater for our kaitautoko that less than 25 people used. This rōpū will travel across to watch our rōpū perform at Claudelands Events Centre in Hamilton on 6 November, returning to Mangakino later on this same day. This rōpū will return to Masterton at 5.30pm on Thursday the 7th of November 2019.

The **kapa tautoko rōpū bus**. Year 1 – 3 tamariki (except for those year 3 tamariki in the kapa haka rōpū), and wharekura tamariki only can go on the kapa tautoko bus. Year 1 to Year 3 tamariki who are travelling on this bus, must have a parent or care-giver travel with them. This rōpū will be staying in Mangakino. There will be a **cost of \$75 per adult** travelling on this bus; and a cost of \$45 for non-kura siblings which will cover all expenses (other than your own personal ones). This amount will need to be **paid in full no later than 18 October**. Please note there are **no refunds** should you later decide not to travel with this rōpū. There is no cost for our kura students travelling on this bus.
