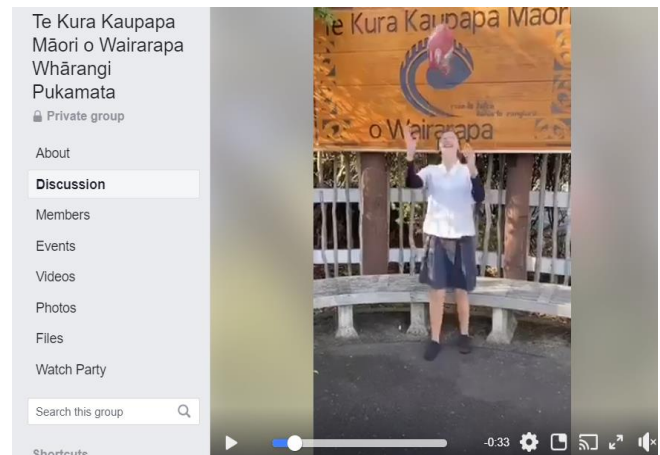


E whai ake nei ngā pitopito kōrero a Irihāpeti:

*On 5<sup>th</sup> of June 2020, The Minister of Conservation, Hon Eugenie Sage, Treaty Partners Rangitāne Tū Mai Rā Trust and KKWKT and other stakeholders joined to celebrate the governments support of Wairarapa Moana's application for Ramsar status. It was a wonderful milestone to be witness to that which has been in the pipeline for more than five years! The convention aims to help protect rare or unique wetlands, or wetlands that are important for conserving biological diversity.*

*The day began with a mihi whakatau from Ngāti Hinewaka, followed by a kōrero given by Rāwiri Smith. Proceeding the formalities, three kahikatea were planted to mark this day of significance, which also happens to be International Conservation Day! Ka nui te pai!*
